WHAT IS EUROVELO?

EuroVelo is the European Cycle Route Network, consisting of 17 long-distance routes that cross and connect the entire continent.

Developed and coordinated by the European Cyclists' Federation (ECF), this network enables long-distance cycle tourists and local people to make daily journeys by bicycle.

Touro is situated on the last stage of the Pilgrims' Route on their way to Compostela.



THE DUTCHMAN'S WAY

The EuroVelo 3, also known as the "Dutchman's Route", crosses the beautiful municipality of Touro along the regional road AC-240. Touro is an excellent stop for cycle tourists who wish to explore the Galician capital the following morning.

Did you know that more than thirty years ago, Dutch cycle tourists started to map out a cycling alternative to the French Way, coinciding with the EuroVelo 3? Clemens Sweerman edited the Dutchman's Guide to the Camino, consolidating Touro as a preferred destination for cycle tourists from the north.
